We have cut back to two newsletters a year due to finances, so it has been a while since you heard from us. Dale and I just got back from Honduras. We had a wonderful time and saw God working in so many ways. I won't rehash the things that are listed in the Honduras article, but I do want to share a little.

The children of Honduras just touch my heart. Pat Collins and I worked with around 80 children a day in Las Vegas—Honduras not Nevada. They are precious and love overcomes language barriers. I do think I am getting too old to be out in the hot sun running around and playing games, but I did it although I don't know how much longer I can do that.

We always take candy, gum and gifts to pass out, and I love giving little gifts in all the places we go. As we were leaving Victoria to go to Tegucigalpa, about a 6 hour drive, we had promised the children hanging around outside some candy. I forgot and left the candy bag sitting on the table. The house was already locked and we couldn't get in. I cried a long way down the road. I couldn't help it after I saw the anticipation on their little faces and then the disappointment when we told them we had left it inside. Dale promised me they would get lots of candy when he got back with the second team.

We gave out 200 meals at the dump. It has gotten violent since the economy has gotten worse. It is always traumatic seeing people living in the dump, but to see the young hoodlums knocking children and old people away just broke my heart. This may be the last dump feeding. Please pray for us as we continue to seek God's will.
